

CDBG-DR BUYOUT PROGRAM APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE JULY 8, 2020

The City of Sour Lake has been awarded Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Funds to assist property owners affected by Hurricane Harvey. The City encourages residents whose homes are located in floodplains, floodways and Disaster Risk Reduction Areas to relocate to safer, more resilient housing in less flood prone areas through participation in its Local Buyout Program. Property owners interested in participating in the program will need to complete an application and provide required documentation on or before September 7, 2020.
